

Jury Clears Husband Who Killed Wife by Mistake

Matthew Chiarenza, 4517 South St. Louis avenue, was exonerated yesterday by a coroner's jury which investigated the fatal shooting of his wife Philomena, 25 years old. Mrs. Chiarenza, a bride of five months, died yesterday morning at Holy Cross hospital from the wound inflicted on Wednesday night when her husband shot her, mistaking her for a burglar. When the verdict of accidental death was read Chiarenza buried his head in his hands and wept.
