VET KILLS WIFE WHO REFUSED TO LIVE WITH HIM

Chicago, Dec. 17—An inquest will be held today into the murder and suicide of Mrs. Eillean Dellitt Greene, 24, and her husband, Harry Greene, a disabled war veteran.

The tragedy occurred at the home of the bride's mother, Mrs. Allen Rellitt. Greene went there to make a final plea with his wife of six months, who married him on a "dare," to share a home with him.

When she refused, Greene embraced her and fired a bullet into the back of her head. He knelt and prayed a moment and then turned the gun on himself.

Mrs. Dellitt witnessed the tragedy. She collapsed in the street after running for help.

Greene met his wife at Speedway hospital, where he was con-
