

KILLED BY HUSBAND SHE MARRIED ON DARE

Chicago, Dec. 17.—An inquest will be held today into the murder and suicide of Mrs. Eillean Dellitt Greene, 24, and her husband, Harry Greene, a disabled World war veteran.

The tragedy occurred at the home of the bride's mother, Mrs. Allen Dellitt. Greene went there to make a final plea with his wife of six months, who married him on a "dare," to share a home with him.

When she refused, Greene embraced her and fired a bullet into the back of her head. He knelt and prayed a moment and then turned the gun on himself.
